



DAVAO CITY TOROTOT FEST

COMPETITION GUIDELINES

I. GIANT TOROTOT COMPETITION

1. Competition is open to all Barangays in Davao City.
2. Giant Torotot must have the following requirements:
 - a. Entry must be 1 piece of torotot only.
 - b. Height of torotot must be at least 4 feet and not more than 8 feet.
 - c. Torotot must produce a loud sound when blown.
 - d. Entry must have its own customized stand for the Torotot. Tables or chairs used as stand are not allowed.
 - e. No foul or inappropriate design / visuals on the torotot.
 - f. No petroleum brand allowed on the design, other than Phoenix.
 - g. Violation of the above requirements will get demerits (minus points).
3. Each Barangay must submit the following:
 - a. Duly filled-out entry form signed by their Barangay Captain
 - b. 2 photocopies of representative's valid ID
4. Entry forms are available at the City Tourism Operations Office located at the 2nd floor of Pasalubong Center, Palma Gil St., Davao City (near People's Park) and at the following Phoenix gas stations:
 - a. *Phoenix Gmall TORIL*
 - b. *Phoenix PONCIANO*
 - c. *Phoenix LANANG*
5. Entry forms and other requirements must be submitted to the City Tourism Operations Office. Only entries with complete requirements will be accepted. **Deadline of submission is on DECEMBER 20, 2018 Thursday at 4:00PM.**
6. **NO registration fee.**
7. There will be a meeting of representatives of all registered entries to discuss details of the competition at the _____ on **DECEMBER 21, 2018 Friday at 2:00PM.**
8. Qualified entries should be at Rizal Park, Davao City to set up their Torotot at 5:00-6:00PM on December 31, 2018. Late arrival of entries (after 6:00PM) will have a deduction of 1 point for every 5 minutes or a fraction thereof from their total final scores.
9. Representatives from participating Barangays must be present during the NEW YEAR'S EVE PROGRAM on December 31, 2018 at Rizal Park, Davao City. It is the responsibility of each Barangay to assign person/s to secure/guard their entry during the entire program.
10. Torotot entries should be functional and in good shape during the pre-judging happening before the program proper until the announcement of winners.

13. Representatives of the Barangay must be present during the announcement and awarding of winners.
14. Cash prizes will only be released to the official representative of the Barangay indicated on their entry form.

II. TOROTOT-INSPIRED COSTUME COMPETITION

1. Competition is open to residents of Davao City only.
2. Costume entries must have the following requirements:
 - a. Entry must be worn by 1 person only during the pre-judging, parade of entries and announcement of winners during the New Year's Eve Countdown program.
 - b. Costume must resemble or feature a Torotot on its design.
 - c. No foul or inappropriate design / visuals on the costume.
 - d. Body of the wearer should be appropriately covered by the costume. No indecent exposures allowed.
 - e. No petroleum brand allowed on the design, other than Phoenix.
 - f. Designer may wear his/her own costume during the program OR another person can be assigned to wear it to represent the designer.
 - g. Violation of the above requirements will get demerits (minus points).
3. Each entry must submit the following:
 - a. Duly filled-out entry form,
 - b. Proof of residency / barangay certificate of designer
 - c. 2 photocopies of designer's valid ID
4. Entry forms are available at the City Tourism Operations Office located at the 2nd floor of Pasalubong Center, Palma Gil St., Davao City (near People's Park) and at the following Phoenix gas stations:
 - a. *Phoenix Gmall TORIL*
 - b. *Phoenix PONCIANO*
 - c. *Phoenix LANANG*
5. Entry forms and other requirements must be submitted to the City Tourism Operations Office. Only entries with complete requirements will be accepted. **Deadline of submission is on DECEMBER 20, 2018 Thursday at 4:00PM.**
6. **No registration fee.**
7. There will be a meeting of all registered participants to discuss details of the competition at the _____ on **DECEMBER 21, 2018 Friday at 3:00PM.**
8. Qualified entries should be at Rizal Park, Davao City on or before 7:00PM on December 31, 2018. Late arrival of entries (after 7:00PM) will have a deduction of 1 point for every 5 minutes or a fraction thereof from their total final scores.
9. Costumes must be worn, functional and in good shape during the pre-judging happening before the program proper and during the parade of entries on stage.

III. TOROTOT DANCE COMPETITION

1. Performing groups based in Davao City are qualified to join.
2. Entries must have the following requirements:
 - a. Each group must be composed of a minimum of eight (8) and a maximum of ten (10) dancers, all male/female or mixed. Less or more than the required number of dancers during the competition, for whatever reason the group may have, will automatically disqualify the group.
 - b. Dance may be any street or urban-based style and may also be combined with other genres of dance.
 - c. Performance must be 3 minutes (minimum) to 5 minutes (maximum) only. One (1) point shall be deducted by each judge for every five (5) seconds short or five (5) seconds exceeding the time limit. Timing of performance will start from the 1st note of the music or 1st choreographed movement and ends at the last note of music or choreographed movement, whatever is applicable.
 - d. Performance must incorporate TOROTOT as props. The choreography, music and costume may also be TOROTOT-inspired, as this is part of the criteria.
 - e. Each group must wear appropriate and decent costumes.
 - f. Only handheld props are allowed. Use of big props, backdrop, pyrotechnic gadgets, smoke or combustible materials is not allowed.
 - g. No petroleum brand allowed on costume design and in music, other than Phoenix.
 - h. Violation of the above requirements will get demerits (minus points).
3. Each entry must submit the following:
 - a. Duly filled-out entry form
 - b. 2 photocopies of representative's valid ID
 - c. Waiver
4. Entry forms are available at the City Tourism Operations Office (CTOO) located at the 2nd floor of Pasalubong Center, Palma Gil St., Davao City (near People's Park) and at the following Phoenix gas stations:
 - a. Phoenix Gmall TORIL
 - b. Phoenix PONCIANO
 - c. Phoenix LANANG
5. Entry forms and other requirements must be submitted to the City Tourism Operations Office. Only entries with complete requirements will be accepted. **Deadline of submission is on DECEMBER 20, 2018 Thursday at 4:00PM.**
6. **NO registration fee.**
7. Maximum of 12 groups will be accepted in the competition.
8. There will be a meeting of representatives of all registered groups to discuss details of the competition at the _____ on **DECEMBER 21, 2018 Friday at 4:00PM.**
9. Deadline of submission of music in a flash drive (usb) is on **DECEMBER 28, 2018 Friday at 4:00PM.** Music must not contain foul language.
10. Qualified groups should be at Rizal Park, Davao City on or before 8:00PM on December 31, 2018. Groups who are not complete and not in costume after 8:00PM will have a deduction of 1 point for every 5 minutes or a fraction thereof from their total final scores.
11. Sequence of performances will be determined through drawing lots.
